The town is replacing the old fractured sidewalk that runs from our church's gravel driveway to the back parking lot all the way to the front gate along Back Street. When the town's work crew peeled away that sidewalk, guess what they found? Another, even older sidewalk underneath! That sidewalk will serve as the foundation for the new and much safer sidewalk.

Looking at the old sidewalk before it was "peeled away" and the even older sidewalk underneath made me think about the great number of people that walked upon this old sidewalk and its even older predecessor during their life times. I also thought about the generations of people who walked along Back Street even before either sidewalk was laid. After all, the Fincastle Presbyterian church has stood on its property since 1770, and I assume Back Street has served as a thoroughfare since even before then. That represents a lot of history!
