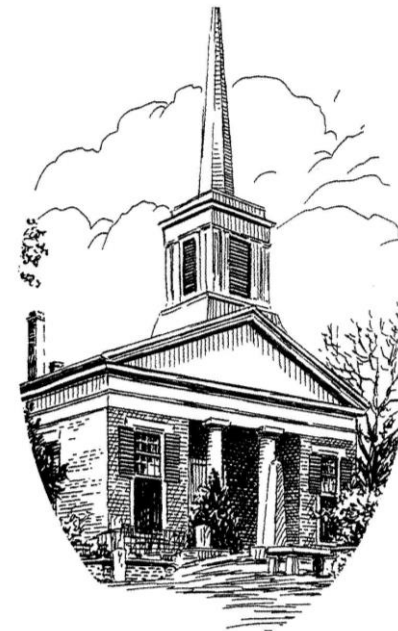

Psalm 30

¹ I will extol thee, O Lord, for thou hast drawn me up, and hast not let my foes rejoice over me. ² O Lord my God, I cried to thee for help, and thou hast healed me. ³ O Lord, thou hast brought up my soul from Sheol, restored me to life from among those gone down to the Pit. ⁴ Sing praises to the Lord, O you his saints, and give thanks to his holy name. ⁵ For his anger is but for a moment, and his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning. ⁶ As for me, I said in my prosperity, "I shall never be moved." ⁷ By thy favor, O Lord, thou hadst established me as a strong mountain; thou didst hide thy face, I was dismayed. ⁸ To thee, O Lord, I cried; and to the Lord I made supplication: ⁹ "What profit is there in my death, if I go down to the Pit? Will the dust praise thee? Will it tell of thy faithfulness?" ¹⁰ Hear, O Lord, and be gracious to me! O Lord, be thou my helper!" ¹¹ Thou hast turned for me my mourning into dancing; thou hast loosed my sackcloth and girded me with gladness, ¹² that my soul may praise thee and not be silent. O Lord my God, I will give thanks to thee for ever.

John 21:1-10

¹ After this Jesus revealed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tibe'ri-as; and he revealed himself in this way. ² Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin, Nathan'a-el of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zeb'edee, and two others of his disciples were together. ³ Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We will go with you." They went out and got into the boat; but that night they caught nothing. ⁴ Just as day was breaking, Jesus stood on the beach; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. ⁵ Jesus said to them, "Children, have you any fish?" They answered him, "No." ⁶ He said to them, "Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in, for the quantity of fish. ⁷ That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his clothes, for he was stripped for work, and sprang into the sea. ⁸ But the other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, but about a hundred yards off. ⁹ When they got out on land, they saw a charcoal fire there, with fish lying on it, and bread. ¹⁰ Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish that you have just caught."
