- ¹ The word which Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.
- ² It shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established as the highest of the mountains,

and shall be raised above the hills;
and all the nations shall flow to it,

and many peoples shall come, and say:
"Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob;
that he may teach us his ways and that we may walk in his paths."

- 1 Songs of thankfulness and praise, Jesus, Lord, to you we raise, once revealed, when heaven's star brought the wise men from afar; Branch of royal David's stem in your birth at Bethlehem, Word before the world began, God revealed to us in man.
- 2 God revealed at Jordan's stream, prophet, priest and king supreme, once revealed in power divine changing water into wine:
 Cana's holy wedding guest keeping to the last the best,
 Word before the world began,
 God revealed to us in man.
- 3 God revealed in valiant fight, conquering the devil's might, sins forgiven, sickness healed, life restored and God revealed: once revealed in gracious will ever bringing good from ill, Word before the world began, God revealed to us in man.
- 4 Stars shall fall and heavens fade, sun and moon shall dark be made; Christ will then like lightning shine, all will see the glorious sign: all will then the trumpet hear, all will see the Son appear, Word before the world began, God revealed to us in man.

#311 God Has Spoken by His Prophets

- 1 God hath spoken by the prophets, spoken the unchanging Word, each from age to age proclaiming God the one, the righteous Lord. In the world's despair and turmoil one firm anchor holds us fast: God is king, his throne eternal, God the first, and God the last.
- 2 God hath spoken by Christ Jesus, Christ, the everlasting Son, brightness of the Father's glory, with the Father ever one; spoken by the Word incarnate, God of God, ere time was born; Light of Light, to earth descending, Christ, as God in human form.
- 3 God is speaking by his Spirit, speaking to our hearts again; in the agelong Word expounding God's own message, now as then. Through the rise and fall of nations one sure faith yet standing fast: God abides, his Word unchanging, God the first, and God the last.

#745 Jesus Shall Reign

- 1 Jesus shall reign where'er the sun does its successive journeys run; his kingdom spread from shore to shore, till moons shall wax and wane no more.
- 2 To him shall endless prayer be made, and endless praises crown his head; his name like sweet perfume shall rise with every morning sacrifice.
- 3 People and realms of every tongue dwell on his love with sweetest song, and infant voices shall proclaim their early blessings on his name.
- 4 Blessings abound where'er he reigns; the prisoners leap to lose their chains, the weary find eternal rest, and all who suffer want are blessed.
