

# Isaiah 49:1-7

<sup>1</sup> Listen to me, O coastlands, and hearken, you peoples from afar. The LORD called me from the womb, from the body of my mother he named my name.
<sup>2</sup> He made my mouth like a sharp sword, in the shadow of his hand he hid me; he made me a polished arrow, in his quiver he hid me away.
<sup>3</sup> And he said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will be glorified."
<sup>4</sup> But I said, "I have labored in vain, I have spent my strength for nothing and vanity; yet surely my right is with the LORD, and my recompense with my God."

 <sup>5</sup> And now the LORD says, who formed me from the womb to be his servant, to bring Jacob back to him, and that Israel might be gathered to him, for I am honored in the eyes of the LORD, and my God has become my strength—

# John 1:29-42

<sup>29</sup> The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! <sup>30</sup> This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks before me, for he was before me.' <sup>31</sup> I myself did not know him; but for this I came baptizing with water, that he might be revealed to Israel." <sup>32</sup> And John bore witness, "I saw the Spirit descend as a dove from heaven, and it remained on him. <sup>33</sup> I myself did not know him; but he who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this is he who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' <sup>34</sup> And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God."
