It dates back to before the American Civil War but remained unpublished until 1918, when it was included in Plantation Melodies: A collection of Modern, Popular and Old-time Negro-Songs of the Southland. The song refers to biblical imagery such as baptism (white robe), the River Jordan, Jesus (Prince of Peace) and heaven (road to heaven). The song centers around abandoning aggression and putting on new spiritual clothing at the side of the river before crossing it.
